For 190 years, the Kingston Fall Fair has been celebrating local agriculture through a weekend festival featuring horse riding competitions, cattle shows, music performances, homecraft and culinary arts competitions, petting zoos, tractor pulls, demolition derbies, motocross, 4H displays, vendor markets, a midway, and much more!

Now in its 191st year, the fair is back with all the fun and family-oriented events and attractions that make it Kingston's largest and most historic festival. About The Education Day



Working with the Limestone District School Board, the education day will bring over eight hundred Kingston and area students to visit a variety of educational stations and spend the day with farm and barnyard friends.

By educating our youth on agriculture and introducing them to the animals and practises that make our way of life possible, we help build their appreciation for life, food, and our natural resources. Through exhibits featuring wasps and bees, rabbits, chickens, pigs, and horses, we can demonstrate the dynamic web of agriculture that sustains us. Participants will spend the day moving from station to station, with each station introducing a different and important aspect of farming and the natural world. The pages below speak to many of these stations. We hope your company might select a station to sponsor or become a

Education Day Stations



Barnyard Petting Zoo

The Barnyard Petting Zoo will give our students the opportunity to have close encounters with goats, lamas, donkeys, and other barnyard animals that populate our rural areas. Students will have the opportunity to meet and greet fun and friendly animals and develop empathy for our furry friends.



Diversity of Living Things Stage Show

Meet reptiles, mammals, invertebrates, and birds—including a large snake, a giant rabbit, and a crocodile. Our audience will learn about animal behaviour, habitats, conservation, and how they got so big in a demonstration that is safe and healthy for animals and people alike.

Nutrition and Growing Food

KFL&A Public Health and Loving Spoonful offer education on healthy eating and healthy growing at this community and health-focused station. Students will access interactive health learning activities while learning the importance of our city's community gardens and local food systems.



Bee Keeping & The Importance of Wasps

Our Bee and Wasp Station, provided by professional beekeepers, and the Gananoque Wasp Nest Museum will demonstrate the importance of insects to our food systems. Our bee station includes a standing, glass-covered beehive full of bees and a challenge for young people to spot the queen. Beekeepers will be onsite to speak with attending students, talk through the making of honey, and provide delicious samples. Our local wasp nest museum will be onsite with a variety of wasp nests to speak to the importance of insect predation as crop pest control.

The Chicken Coup

This is the year of the chicken at the Kingston Fall Fair, with a variety of chicken-related activities for our students to participate in. The centre piece of our chicken theme day is the Chicken Coup, a large enclosure occupied by a variety of egg-laying chickens. Accompanying the coup is signage explaining the different breeds of chickens and the difference between a meat chicken and a layer. This display will provide a close encounter with an animal so important to our culture and the food system. Through this, we hope that we might bring our young people to a deeper level of meaning and respect for the food we eat.





The Fair Exhibit and Competition

Every year, hundreds of artists and growers compete in the fair's exhibits and competitions. The competition invites entries from the culinary arts, flower, fruit, and vegetable growers, crafters, and artists to compete for best-in-class prizes. Students and visitors will tour the crafting area, view the variety of entries, and see the competition winners.



Rabbits & Quail

Livestock comes in a variety of sizes, and our rabbit and quail station invites students to learn from rabbit and quail keepers and meet and handle some of the smaller creatures that make up our food system. The station includes a variety of rabbits and quail with information on the different breeds, including the fibre-growing Angora rabbit.





Sheep Shearing

This live demonstration of sheep shearing will show students how wool is gathered and help them understand the importance of sheep and sheep farmers to our textile system. The demonstration will include information on sheep care and how wool moves from the sheep's coat to become the clothing we wear.



Swiftwind Equine Centre will be onsite with ponies, Cupcake and Brownie, to introduce students to our horse friends and provide interactive education on horse care, including hoof picking, brushing, and how to keep a horse happy and healthy.
