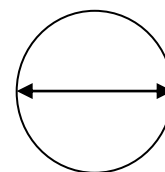
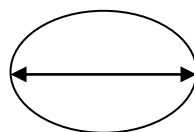
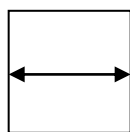
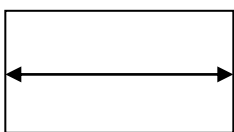
General Entry and Entry tags available at www.kingstonfair.com or fair board office.

SECTION is the number given to a specific competition.

CLASS is an item within a Section (e.g. Section 41, class # 1 – (entry description)-Beans, bush yellow.

Pot/Container Size

Refer to the inside measurement of the container, at the top. Measure along the lines and arrows as shown in the following diagrams.



RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Rules and Regulations (#1-21) of Kingston and District Agricultural Society “Showcase” where applicable.
2. Only one entry in anyone class.
3. Where more than one member, such as a husband, wife or brother and sister, jointly maintain a garden, only one entry may be made in anyone class.
4. All entries must be grown by the exhibitor, unless otherwise specified. Anyone violating this rule will forfeit all prizes won and will be barred from further competition at any time.
5. Flowers must be shown in suitable containers. No tin cans or jars with labels.
6. All exhibitors must pay \$5.00 Membership Fee..
7. Exhibits will be accepted in the Bennett barn between 9:00 am and 11:00 am. Saturday, September 18th, 2021. No late entries accepted.
8. Exhibits to be picked up between 4:00 and 6:00pm. Saturday, September 18th, 2021.
9. Prize Monies and ribbons will be given to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in both adult and junior sections.
10. No Exhibitor will be entitled to a prize, unless it possesses points of merit and no award will be made to unworthy exhibits, even though there may be only one entry in the class.
11. Where a specific number of specimens are required for an exhibit, a greater or smaller number will disqualify the exhibit.
12. Due care will be taken of the exhibitor’s property, but no responsibility will be taken for loss or damage. Supervision cannot be maintained at all times.
13. Any omissions will be corrected for next year.
14. Entry shown on an open paper or styrofoam plate. Paper Plate will be provide by the competition chairperson.
15. Junior Section: Include exhibitor’s age on the entry tag.
16. Junior exhibitors **can** enter adult sections (41, Special, 43, & 45).

1. Beans, bush yellow - 5 specimens - In a ziploc bag
2. Beans, bush green - 5 specimens - - In a ziploc bag
3. Beets - any 1 variety - 4 specimens - must be shown with ½” stem - In a ziploc bag
4. Carrots, long - 4 specimens - must be shown with ½” stem - - In a ziploc bag
5. White potatoes - 4 specimens - - In a ziploc bag
6. Cucumbers, slicing - 2 specimens - - In a ziploc bag
7. Red tomatoes over 2”- 3 specimens - Stem left on - - In a ziploc bag

SPECIAL - VEGETABLES and FRUITS

8. Largest carrot – In a ziploc bag - Measured from end to tip, not including stem.
9. Largest onion – In a ziploc bag - Measured based on onion circumference.
10. Heaviest potato – In a ziploc bag - Measured in grams. Scale will be provided.
11. Largest tomato – In a ziploc bag - Measured based on tomato circumference.
12. Heaviest beet – In a ziploc bag - Measured in grams. Scale will be provided.
13. Longest bean – In a ziploc bag - Measured from end to tip, not including stem.
14. Longest cucumber – In a ziploc bag - Measured from end to tip, not including stem.

15. Marigold, double, under 2" - 3 blooms
16. Marigold, single, under 2" - 3 blooms
17. Marigold, 2-4" - 3 blooms
18. Petunias grandiflora, single - 3 blooms
19. Petunias multiflora, single - 3 blooms
20. Grasses, ornamental, any one variety, 3 stems.

Note: Do not include plants grown from bulbs or tubers in Annual or Perennial Collection

21. Collection of Annuals - 5 types, no more than 15, displayed in a suitable container.
22. Collection of Perennials -3 types, no more than 9, displayed in a suitable container.
23. Collection of wild flowers, 5 kinds, 3 of each kind, displayed in a suitable container.

1. COUNTRY FAIR - A design using flowers with fruit and/or vegetables. Not to exceed 16" in width.
2. SEPTEMBER SPLENDOR - A design using fall leaves and flowers in a basket. Not to exceed 16" in width.
3. SUNNY DAYS - A design using Sunflowers. Not to exceed 16" in width.
4. EARTHLY DELIGHTS – A design using dried flowers, and or fruits, grasses, pods, seeds, and branches pleasantly displayed. Not to exceed 16" in width.
5. TINTS AND TONES – A design using any one colour. Not to exceed 16" in width.
6. IS THAT A FRUIT OR VEGETABLE? – A design using a fruit or vegetable as your container. Not to exceed 16" in width.
