16. Marigold, single, under 2" - 3 blooms

4. EARTHLY DELIGHTS – A design using dried flowers, and or fruits, grasses, pods, seeds, and branches pleasantly displayed. Not to exceed 16" in width.	
5. TINTS AND TONES – A design using any one colour. Not to exceed 16" in width.	
6. IS THAT A FRUIT OR VEGETABLE? – A design using a fruit or vegetable as your container. Not to exceed 16" in width.	
1.Kooky creature made completely of vegetables/fruits - named. Maximum length/width 16"	
2.A sunflower made into a face with all natural material. Maximum width 16"	
3. Mr. Potato Head (made from a potato and other vegetables). No maximum size	
4. A vegetable/fruit that resembles an animal or object – named animal/object. Maximum length/width 16"	
5. Pumpkin, decorated (NOT CARVED), judged for originality - be creative. Maximum length/width 16"
