5. If not a current member of KDAS, purchase 2022 membership at the Beef Farmers of Frontenac desk.
6. All Cattle must be on the grounds by 10:00 am Sunday September 18th.
7. All Cattle must be in good health.
8. All Cattle to remain on fair grounds for the public to view until Sunday at 3:00pm.

5. If not a current member of KDAS, purchase 2022 membership from the Beef Farmers of Frontenac desk.
6. Top steers must be sold by auction at the Kingston Fall Fair. KDAS will receive 2% of gross revenue of each steer.
7. All steers must be in good health.
8. Steers were born in year prior to the Show and Sale and should be properly dehorned and castrated.
